Laura's House was founded in 1994, by a group of concerned citizens, to provide domestic violence-related services to the more than 840,000 residents of Orange County, California. Our Mission is to Change social beliefs, attitudes and the behaviors that perpetuate domestic violence while creating a safe space in which to empower individuals and families affected by abuse.

Laura's House is a state-approved comprehensive domestic violence agency which serves clients from all areas of Orange County. In our first ten years, Laura's House has provided shelter and support services to more than 2,000 women and children, and counseling, life skills education and legal aide to more than 14,000 victims. Annually, Laura's House provides residential shelter services to more than 200 homeless women and children; counseling and violence prevention education to more than 800 women, children and teens; legal services to more than 450 clients as well as assisting with more than 1,200 crisis hot-line calls. Our goal is to provide support programs that will prepare our clients and their children to live independent and violence-free lives and prevention programs aimed at breaking the multigenerational cycle of violence to create healthier families



Our target population is families experiencing the effects of domestic violence in need of emergency shelter, support, education and counseling. Laura's House operates on the philosophy that domestic violence is multi-dimensional and often cyclical in nature and must be addressed through a range of interventions. Our goal is to provide supportive service programs that will prepare our clients and their children to live independent and violence free lives.

Influenced by the growing social needs of the community in which it works, Laura's House has responded by developing innovative residential and outreach programs to meet the unique needs of population groups such as Hispanic families, at risk teens and preschool children, each coping with the effects of domestic violence. Our success as an agency relies on our commitment to constantly appraise our services, renew our results and search for opportunities to improve and expand.
