Thank you for your interest in starting a school club! Laura's House HEART school clubs are on-campus, student-lead clubs working to raise awareness about Teen Dating Violence through awareness campaigns, fundraising events and other activities. Organizing on your campus can help build a broader base of support for addressing and preventing Teen Dating Abuse, Domestic Violence and Bullying. All school clubs must have a club president, cabinet members and a school faculty advisor; such as a teacher. The Laura's House Prevention Education Specialist (PES) team will be your Laura's House advisors and point of contact for the agency.

Getting Started

- ✓ Create a club name.
- ✓ Create a mission statement.
- ✓ Create a club purpose.
- ✓ Choose cabinet members for the club and delegate responsibilities.
- ✓ Find an advisor at your school.
- ✓ Secure School Administration Support/Approval.
- ✓ Complete Laura's House HEART School Club Registration Form.
- ✓ Set up a meeting with Laura's House PES Team.
- ✓ Recruit club members.

Sample Calendar Outline

1. First Meeting – introduce club mission and purpose.
2. Brainstorm – brainstorm with club members ideas for club activities.
